TOXICITY

Apply using accurately calibrated and maintained equipment in accordance with the New Zealand Standard for the Management of Agrichemicals (NZS8409).

Flush equipment thoroughly with clean water after use according to Cleaning Spray Equipment instructions below. Dispose of cleaning water according to the Disposal instructions below.

STORAGE

Store in the original container tightly closed and in a locked, dry, cool, well ventilated area, away from heat and foodstuffs.

Storage must be generally in accordance with the New Zealand Standard for the Management of Agrichemicals (NZS8409). Stores containing 1000L or more of **BOOST PENETRANT** require bunding and are subject to signage. See the Hazardous Substances Emergency Management and Identification Regulations and the New Zealand Standard for the Management of Agrichemicals (NZS8409) for further information.

PERSONAL PROTECTION

When mixing wear face mask or goggles, chemical resistant gloves and footwear and cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist.

SPILLAGE

DO NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear the protective equipment recommended above. Stop leak when safe to do so. Dike area and prevent entry into waterways, and drains. **Small spills/leaks:** Absorb with proprietary absorbent suitable for chemical spills or inert material such as sand, soil or sawdust. Collect spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Spill residues may be cleaned using water and detergent. Contain and absorb wash water for disposal. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the SDS, product label or Corteva Agriscience regarding disposal. **Large spills/leaks:** Dike the area of large spills and report them to Corteva Agriscience Emergency Services at 0800 844 455.

DISPOSAL

Triple rinse the empty container and add rinsate to spray tank. Triple rinsed containers containing the Agrecovery logo on the label and that are free of all residues (liquid and dry) and have an intact legible label may be taken to an **Agrecovery** collection site. Otherwise crush carefully and bury in a suitably approved landfill. **DO NOT** burn empty containers.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

An organosilicone penetrant for improved coverage, penetration, uptake and rainfastness of Tordon™ Brushkiller XT, Tordon Brushkiller, Grazon™, glyphosate and other herbicides that recommend the use of a quality organosilicone penetrant for broadacre and brushweed spraying. The addition of **BOOST PENETRANT** increases the reliability of these herbicides on target weeds when plants are dormant or stressed such as in hot, dry, frosty or salty conditions or when previously slashed or grazed. Check herbicide label for specific details of application rate and method.

Recommended uses:

Grazon, Tordon Brushkiller XT

Gorse, Broom and other brushweeds

Broadcast application (Aerial or Ground) - 2L **BOOST PENETRANT** / ha

Brushgun, knapsack - 100ml **BOOST PENETRANT** / 100L spray mix

Use with glyphosate herbicides

General weed control

Boom - 100ml **BOOST PENETRANT** / 100L spray mix and appropriate rate of glyphosate

Handgun - 100-200ml **BOOST PENETRANT** / 100L spray mix and appropriate rate of glyphosate

Knapsack - 30ml **BOOST PENETRANT** / 15L spray mix and appropriate rate of glyphosate

For all products containing glyphosate refer to the respective label for use rates. Always use **BOOST PENETRANT** if treating gorse, broom, bracken or ryegrass.

MIXING:

Mixing: Add **BOOST PENETRANT** when tank is 85% full to reduce foaming. Circulate or agitate before spraying.

Rainfall: The addition of **BOOST PENETRANT** to Tordon Brushkiller XT, Tordon Brushkiller, Grazon, glyphosate and other herbicides for broadacre and brushweed spraying reduces the rainfree period to 30 minutes when label recommended rates are sprayed on dry foliage.

NOTE:

The use of **BOOST PENETRANT** increases the visibility of the spraymix on the plant, and may entice the applicator to under apply the herbicide. It is important that the herbicide label directions are followed.

CLEANING SPRAY EQUIPMENT

To rinse and decontaminate spray equipment refer to the relevant product labels for instructions.
